Pahang Darul Makmur – Commenting on the recent information in relation to slight tremors felt at the Bukit Tinggi area, near Bentong in Pahang, we would like to reassure guests and prospective travelers that it is business as usual, in fact booming at Berjaya Hills. The tremors that took place recently were a non-event.

In light of the recent new information in the press, Mr Bjorn-Henning Buth, General Manager of Berjaya Hills says, “the tremors were felt in the nearby district of Bukit Tinggi, near Bentong (within half an hour drive from Berjaya Hills) and there has not been any impact on the resort and the public should not be worried. There was no damage to property nor injury to life. The resort continues to boom.
